

Glazing and Firing 2026

We've noticed that the large amount of work being made at home has an impact on our workflow. For external makers, we need to be a bit more selective. Also we've added new credits in the shop for those who work from home but would still like to use our glazes and kiln.

- * Email us first before bringing in your work. Include the amount and type of clay you've used, and specify whether it's for a bisque or glaze firing.
- * If you'd like to do a bisque firing, make sure your work is completely dry before bringing it in. We don't have enough shelf space to let home-made work dry in the studio.
- * If your work was made during an open studio session, you are entitled to use our glazes. You can glaze during the open studio or book glazing hours for €18 per 2 hours.
- * If your work was made outside Keramiek Garage but you'd like to glaze it here, you can purchase special credits for this. The cost is €28 per 2 hours.
- * You can also have your work fired only, provided we have kiln space available. We have a 120L kiln (Ø42 cm) and a 60L kiln (Ø35 cm). Bisque is fired at 980°C, earthenware at 1040°C, and stoneware at 1250°C.

- To ensure correct firing, please bring the clay/glaze label with any externally made work.
- * The cost for firing work made during the open studio is €5 per kilo per firing, and €10 per kilo per firing for work made outside Keramiek Garage. After firing, your work will be weighed and can be paid in cash (VAT not applied). By card, or by invoice with an additional 21% VAT.
- * If you'd like to fire at a specific temperature or have a larger amount of work, you can rent an entire kiln:
- €75 cash for the 60L kiln
- €100 cash for the 120L kiln
 (by card, or by invoice with an additional 21%)

Please note that our kilns are <u>not</u> available for:

- experiments
- external makers with high-volume,
 regular production or commercial use
